Tucked away in the Miami River area, Crust Pizza USA makes more than just amazing pizzas. Chef Klime Kovaceski (formerly of Crystal Cafe and Trio on the Bay) displays the depth of his talents with a menu that serves everything (in large portions) from solid fettucine alfredo and meatball dishes, savory garlic rolls, fresh kale or Mediterranean salads and seafood dishes like pecan crusted trout and mahi mahi 'francese style' that tickle the tastebuds. The space is romantic in an eclectic way, with mixed-matched seating and a large wine bar, and the free valet parking is a plus — a true hideaway where conversation can take place and isn't drowned by loud music. The chef's wife, Anita, greets you upon arrival with such warmth, you would think you are being invited into their home — a secret restaurant known only to their best friends.
